**SUPPORTING THE ORLAND CEMETERY DISTRICT'S APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES ARMY  
DONATION PROGRAM FOR THE ACQUISITION AND PUBLIC DISPLAY OF DECOMMISSIONED MILITARY  
EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Army Donation Program provides surplus military equipment to qualified organizations for public display in recognition of military service and sacrifice; and

**WHEREAS**, the Orland Cemetery District desires to participate in the United States Army Donation Program to obtain a piece of decommissioned military equipment for commemorative purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed display location is the Independent Order of Odd Fellows (IOOF) Cemetery, located at 3900 County Road P, Orland, California 95963; and

**WHEREAS**, the display is intended to honor the service and sacrifice of veterans and provide a place of reflection, remembrance, and community pride; and

**WHEREAS**, the Orland Cemetery District currently inters more than 1,400 veterans and is approaching its 100-year anniversary in 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, the Orland Cemetery District has agreed to assume all costs associated with the acquisition, transportation, installation, maintenance, preservation, security, and public safety of the donated equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Orland Cemetery District has acknowledged responsibility for complying with all requirements, conditions, and guidelines established by the United States Army Donation Program and any applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Glenn County Board of Supervisors recognizes the value of honoring military service and supporting local efforts to preserve the legacy and sacrifices of our nation's veterans.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Glenn County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. The Glenn County Board of Supervisors supports the Orland Cemetery District's application to the United States Army Donation Program for the acquisition and public display of decommissioned military equipment at the IOOF Cemetery in Orland, California.
2. The Board finds that the proposed display serves a public purpose by honoring veterans and preserving military history for current and future generations.
3. The Board acknowledges that the Orland Cemetery District shall be solely responsible for all costs associated with the acquisition, transportation, installation, maintenance, preservation, security, and public safety of the donated equipment.
4. Adoption of this Resolution does not obligate the County of Glenn to provide funding, maintenance, staffing, or any other financial or operational support for the proposed display.


5. The Clerk of the Board is directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Orland Cemetery District for inclusion with its application materials.
